DOS lobbyist disclosure website, and the dramatic increase proposed to the lobbyist registration fee.

As I reported at the I a s t membership

meeting, DOS is revising its proposed fee increase from \$700 to \$400 based on feedback it received from PAGR, PAGR members and others. While we appreciate the fact that DOS reached out to PAGR to discuss the proposed increase, we are on record opposing the fee increase at \$700 and will continue to do so at \$400.

We believe the increase is an unnecessary tax on our community (most of whom already pay a lobbying tax);

I wish I could report to you that DOS will revise it's proposed fee based on our most recent conversation; I can't. What I can tell you is that they are committed to addressing a number of accuracy and usability issues that plague the DOS website. These include: improving the search function, adding auto suggest options when reporting or searching online, adding features that would allow registrants to link edits and updates to their firms, lobbyists and/or clients across those registrations; and simplifying paper reporting to closer replicate the online experience.

We look forward to working together with DOS as they work towards a more reliable and accurate product. We will continue to voice our opposition to fee increases that treat a regulated community as a revenue source and nothing more. \oplus
