### THE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

#### **Our Little Corner of the World**

PAGR was pleased to have Rep. Bryan Cutler join our membership luncheon recently to talk about his legislation, HB 103, which he drafted to address deliberate failure to comply with the registration and reporting requirements for lobbyists. At the time, his bill was moving rapidly through the

House, and was expected to be voted within days of his presentation. PAGR members expressed concerns with specific provisions in his bill, and as a result of follow-up discussions between Representative Cutler, PAGR board members, and others in the lobbying community, a series of amendments has been drafted to address many of those issues. Rep. Cutler will be working with the Senate to amend the bills.

Coincidentally, many of the problems perceived with the bill relate directly to issues with the system we must use to register and report, and our speaker for the next PAGR member meeting was Carol Aichele, Secretary of the Commonwealth, who at the time of her presentation was awaiting Senate confirmation. Secretary Aichele welcomed the PAGR board request to work together in finding solutions to the difficulties experienced by lobbyists encountering system problems and technical issues that could result in their appearing to be non-compliant. PAGR is following up with Secretary Aichele to determine how best to move forward.

In case you haven't renewed your lobbyist badge and got stuck in that long front door line behind students of all ages, and other groups exercising their rights, you can find details on how to renew on the PAGR website. It's been a busy spring in the capitol, and I can't recall seeing the hallways so crowded in prior years. With the expected mid-June completion of the state budget process, I wonder whether this trend will continue. At least a source of nourishment is available in the capitol once again, for those
