PAGR's Public Affairs Committee has been very busy over the last few weeks. A number of meetings have taken place with those Senate members sponsoring additional lobbying disclosure

legislation. Some of the provisions include: prohibiting a lobbyist from owning, being a partner in or serving as an officer or board member of any consulting firm which receives compensation for providing assistance with political campaigns, prohibits a lobbyist from working in a paid capacity for any political campaign, and lobbying biennial audits.

In addition, the committee will be reviewing Governor Wolf's "Government that Works" Reform Plan for implications on the lobbying community. The plan calls for the banning of gifts, contracting reform, increasing lobbying oversight, and increasing transparency. I would like to thank committee members: Fred Brown, Katie Dotto, Judy Eschberger, Chris Gray, Doug Houser, Mike Maguire, Ted Mowatt, David Tive, Ken Varhola and Jim Willshier, for taking the lead on these issues and representing the PAGR community. We are in very good hands!
