1.0 American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network, Inc. (ACS CAN) Overview

2.0 RFP Goals and Objectives

The primary objective of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to solicit proposals to represent ACS CAN on the topic of Biomarker Testing legislation and to partner with ACS CAN in lobbying the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's General Assembly, Administration, and Departments to ultimately pass Biomarker Testing legislation.

The term of the agreement will be from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.

The contractor will take direction from ACS CAN PA's Government Relations Director, notify this employee of significant developments immediately, and produce written reports to the employee at least once weekly.

Any attempt to bypass the above lines of communication may be perceived as establishing an unfair or biased process and could lead to your disqualification as a potential vendor.

3.5 Selection Process

ACS CAN evaluation team members will evaluate each proposal based upon how it satisfies ACS CAN's requirements. While ACS CAN's evaluation methodology is confidential, ACS CAN is willing to share, at a high level, the major areas of consideration:

- Qualification to be a registered lobbyist
- Vendor does not represent tobacco interests and does not represent other interests that are potentially in conflict with ACS CAN interests
- The level of service and performance standards
- Demonstrated process efficiencies and collaborative approach
- Cost to value ratio
- Vendor industry reputation and experience with the specific issues
- Vendor's experience with the specific government body in the RFP
- Vendor's experience and history with ACS CAN

While cost will remain a critical decision factor, quality, level of service and operating efficiencies that will be realized by ACS CAN are the primary and the most critical aspects. Please be sure to include all essential data in the proposal to ensure ACS CAN has a full and complete understanding of the Vendor's capabilities and experience.
